For the months of January and February, Wilkinson students participated in the Blank Canvases art program, led by artist educator –and Wilkinson parent - Natalie Kauffman. Each class was introduced to a local Toronto artist or art group whereby the students then created a unique piece of art inspired by that artist and their art. The artists covered were Painters 11, Charles Pachter, Jennifer Murphy, Arthur Shilling, Shary Boyle, and Toronto Graffiti artists. Students worked with various media including acrylic paint, collage, drawing media, canvas and modelling clay. All art lessons are connected to the Ontario arts curriculum focus on skill building, selfexpression, problem solving, communication and knowledge acquisition. Put another way, it was learning art using the 4Cs: curiosity, creativity, collaboration and critical thinking - in a fun and educational way!
