Movie Night - REMINDERS

To ensure a safe enjoyable evening for all, here are some important reminders we'd like to share with parents about movie nights at Wilkinson:

- · As with all school events, Wilkinson's code of conduct applies and everyone who attends is expected to display these behaviours.
- · Children, regardless of what grade they are

in, must be accompanied by an adult. This is not a "drop off" event and children arriving at the door without an adult (at least 18 years of age) will not be permitted to enter.

- · Just like at the movie theatre, everyone is to stay seated for the movie; if kids become restless, parents can bring them out to the area outside the gym (Note: the back of the gym is not intended to be a play area during the movie.)
- · Attendees are responsible for cleaning up after themselves Garbage and recycling bins are always in and outside the gym. Any spills should be reported to one of the parent volunteers right away so that they can be mopped up.
- · It is a parent's responsibility to be familiar with the content and rating of the movie being shown. We endeavour to show a variety of movies rated either "G" or "PG" that appeal to both younger and older Wilkinson students so it is up to parents to determine whether a particular movie is appropriate for their child(ren).

Movie Nights are a school council initiative intended bring the Wilkinson community together while at the same time, raising some money to support activities for Wilkinson students.
