**Tuesday, December 4th** we will host a French Immersion Information evening for parents who are considering placing their child in our mid-Immersion program.

Parents of Grade 5/6 Special Education students are invited to learn about the transition to Earl Grey Senior School at an information night on **Wednesday**, **December 5th** from 7:00 -8:00 pm in Room 210, 100 Strathcona Avenue. The evening will be hosted by Special Education staff and Principal Helen Bryce.

On **Monday, December 10th** there will be a School Council meeting. All parents/guardians

are welcome to join us in the staffroom at 7:00 pm.

EAST Alternative School is having an information night for all grade 6 students (and families) interested in applying for entry into the grade 7 program starting in September 2007. Attendance is mandatory for all potential applicants. The date of the open house is **Wednesday, January 23**, 2007 from 6:30-8:30 pm.

A report is going forward to Board on **November 28th** recommending that placement in SK French Immersion (FI) programs be based on proximity and that the lottery process be removed. All applicants are guaranteed a placement but where there are more applicants than spaces, the process would be as follows: Step 1: placement of siblings (as per Board policy re: FI)

Step 2: placement of home school applicants to the "host" school program

Step 3: placement of applicants attending the closest feeder school to their "host" school program

Step 4: placement of applicants in the next closest feeder school

Parents may be concerned that this is a loss of equitable access to the "host" school, previously guaranteed by the lottery. On the other hand, perhaps parents may find this acceptable as long as they can be assured their child will get a spot somewhere.

Parent feedback would be very helpful in understanding the priorities in our area. Parents should feel free to communicate directly with our trustee Cathy Dandy as it is trustees who will be making this decision: (www.cathydandy.ca).
