Cyberpals are strangers. Never meet a cyberpal face-to-face without taking a responsible adult with you. Never give out your personal identity information unless a responsible adult says you can.



Manners

Be a good cyber citizen. Understand your school's Acceptable Use Policy. Copying information from a Web site and pretending it's yours, is plagiarism. Downloading or sharing copyright protected software without the owners' permission is stealing.



Advertising

Learn to recognize online advertisements. Protect yourself, your family and friends by not giving any private identity information to any Web site without first asking permission of a responsible adult.



Research

Smart searching includes trying more than one search site and more than one keyword. Find out how to identify high-quality Web sites. Ask your teacher or librarian to help you find the best information on the Web or in books.



Technology

Cyberspace connects real people and information around the world. Remember to keep your passwords private. Ask your family to use a firewall and anti-virus software to protect your computer and files.

frequently asked question

- **Q:** Does Wilkinson have a safety plan and procedures?
- **A:** Yes. Wilkinson's safety committee (members of Wilkinson's teaching staff) developed the following safety plan:
- · Six fire Drills are conducted each year
- Two meetings are held each year regarding lockdown procedures
- All JK/SK/Grade 1 students are located on the main floor and have access to washrooms on that floor.
- Monitors and cameras are installed and located to monitor the main entrance and main floor
- · Students always leave classrooms in pairs
- All doors except Main Entrance are locked and a "Fob" access system has been installed.
- All staff have access to Walkie-Talkies when on duty or in the yard with their class so they can communicate with other staff and the office.
- All staff are trained in Tribes (a process that develops inclusion (caring and support), influence (meaningful participation) and community (positive expectations)
- Partnerships with School Community
 Liaison Officer and Community Response
- Annual Safe Schools Audit is conducted as mandated by the Ministry
- · Sign in process for visitors to the school
- Safe Arrival Program both mornings and afternoons.

Also, Wilkinson staff and the Council's Health & Safety Committee are reviewing the school's Code of Conduct and will update if necessary.
